At Solution Psychology our passion lies in making a positive impact for our clients by providing excellence in psychological care across the lifespan. We wanted to create a space where our clients felt safe and familiar in the consulting room and comfortable and grounded while they wait.





I developed a model that enabled me to pour my energy into mentoring and supervision and develop a team of professionals to meet the ever growing psychology needs in the northwest of Melbourne. We moved from a two room clinic to a 200 sqm premises, five room clinic, in late 2022 when our search for a new space was proving challenging, which we underwent a renovation to again transform the space to be able to allow us to how more people, this short term solution helped us grow to an eight room clinic while we continued our search for a place we could call home.

In early 2023 we found that space and we set to work, we focussed on creating a space that was intentionally minimal, a space that feels more like a day spa than a clinic, we've created a welcoming environment where you can feel at home. It was equally important to us to create an environment where our team were nurtured with spaces that have been specifically designed to encourage collaboration, research or relaxation between sessions. Our state-of-the-art team centre, resources and testing library, provide our team with the best evidence based resources to add value to our clients sessions. Our relaxation lounge means that our team are refreshed and energised and at their best to help you on your journey.

Our Moonee Ponds clinic at One Dean means we could grow our team and growing our team meant increasing our impact. My vision now is to reduce waiting times for psychological services, deliver a learning environment for the team all within an amazing physical space and in doing so, help as many children, adolescents and families as possible.

CPD: Access your annual CPD budget to complete your professional development goals.


Speed Supervision: Attend our daily 30 minute speed supervision sessions run by our senior psychologists.

Peer Supervision: Attend our fortnightly 60 minute team supervision open to all our team.

External Supervision: access a range of external supervisors enabling you to build skills in areas beyond the expertise of our team such as forensic psychologist.

GPS: Attend our Grow Perform Succeed mid year review session with our leadership team designed to reflect on your progress, plan, set goals and actions.

RRAP-UPS: At the end of each year you will sit down over lunch with our leadership team to reflect on the year, review your performance and plan for the year ahead.

My early career commenced in school-based settings as I believed this to be the ideal role for a new graduate in terms of professional support, collaboration, and scope to explore professional interests. For quite some time, I was unwilling to consider working in private practice as it seemed far too isolating and with little growth to progress. Two years into my



career, I reached out to Melissa, director of Solution Psychology, for professional supervision to ensure I was providing the best care for my clients. OUR GRADUATE PROGRAM

We know that as a Graduate Psychologist, you want your first job to be one that enables you to learn in a supportive environment and give you that kick start that you need to be a great psychologist and have an awesome career.

We also know that you need to transition slowly out of a university mind into professional practice. That's why at Solution Psychology we've created a tailored Graduate Program where you'll have opportunities to be mentored, gain constructive feedback and be surrounded by a great team to collaborate with and learn from.

New graduates will be well supported through our two year program including the option of an internship and or placement for 5+1 or Masters pathway which ensures you are private practice ready. These internships/placement opportunities allow provisional psychologists the opportunity to gain experience and be exposed to the daily operations of a private practice before fully transitioning across to the position of graduate psychologist.

For the right candidate, the first 2 years of your journey with us, might look like this.





GRADUATE PROGRAM

1. Your comprehensive Private Practice Induction and Training Package includes everything related to being an industry leading private practice psychologist.

Topics include;

- How to interact with clients, deliver great consultations, develop a trusting relationship and achieve awesome outcomes.
- How to retain clients and become a psychologist everyone wants to see.
- Learn when to book a client in and how frequently.
- Mental Health Care Plans.
- Navigating the NDIS.
- Developing world class assessment and diagnostic skills.
- Delivering effective, evidence based treatment to make your clients shout your praises to their referring doctor.
- Creating professional GP, paediatrician and specialist letters.
- Working effectively with admin.
- How to nurture referrers so they never want to refer anywhere else.
- How to effectively work with other allied heath professionals such as speech pathologists and occupational therapists to create long term raving fans.
- How to collaborate with teachers and other school staff to great awesome outcomes for your clients.
- How to work effectively with separated families.
- How to structure appointments and manage admin time.
- What to cover in initial consultations.



- 2. You will be assigned a peer mentor, one of our senior psychologist, who will be your support, your sounding board, someone to ask questions and help you be successful. You will meet with this mentor formally weekly as well as have opportunities to connect with them informally.
- 3. Consistent structured mentoring/supervision from our director, team leader and senior psychologists.
- **4.** "In the moment" mentoring through our online platform, and utilising our library of online resources.
- 5. You will have the opportunity to discuss cases every week during our daily "speed supervision" as well as your clinical supervision sessions and during optional monthly peer supervision sessions.
- 6. You will have access to external supervision sessions with our team of external supervisors enabling you to build skills in a range of areas.
- 7. Annual practice CPD and supervision contribution of \$1000 (\$2000 for graduates, years 1-3).
- 8. You will gradually increase your caseload, starting with a graduate load and building slowly to a full caseload.
- 9. A full caseload that includes not more than five client sessions per day leaving 2.5 hours of admin. In a full time week that's almost 2 full days.
- **10.** Access to our registrar program provides the opportunity for you to be on your way to achieving endorsement at your chosen pace.
- 11. Support to develop career goals and establish your own niche area.
- **12.** You will have the opportunity to attend and observe experienced psychologists in the delivery of group programs and interventions.
- **13.** Observe and / or participate in industry leading interventions such as Virtual Reality Therapy (VR).
- **14.** Step away from consulting every quarter for our "Quarter Cuddle" where we have a chance to learn and develop.
- 15. Access to our rewards program.
- **16.** The ability to control your own calendar, whether it be assessments, therapy or school consultations, enjoy the ability to craft your own week.
- 17. Be provided with full admin support to help you focus on your clients and your clinical load.

The transition from student to registering as a psychologist was a steep learning curve. I was very grateful to be part of a practice that provided so much supervision and personal support. The team at Solution Psychology is not like others and sometimes I forget that this is not the norm at other private practices.

What I enjoy most about working in private practice is the opportunity to develop ongoing relationships with clients and their families. I also have a diverse caseload which allows me to support clients with varied clinical presentations. At Solution Psychology, I continue to receive ongoing supervision and professional development.

I was well supported when completing my registrar program and am now registered as an Educational and Developmental psychologist. I was supported in my decision to have two workplaces and am also trusted to take control over my own calendar and caseload.

At Solution Psychology I am always surrounded by other psychologists and a supportive administration team. I rarely feel alone or isolated and know that there is always someone available. The other psychologists at Solution Psychology offer a breadth of experience and are always willing to share this with others.

Something that I found challenging a graduate psychologist in private practice was the business aspect of the job. Like many who choose or are called to a career in psychology, my goal was to help and support vulnerable clients and this was driven by my personal values. When starting out in private practice I found it challenging to charge clients for their session as monetary gain was never a strong value of mine. By identifying this clash in values and seeking support, I was able to learn more about the business structure of private practice which is fundamental in being able to provide ongoing care for my clients.

Now, as an early career psychologist, I can see that I have been well supported to get to this point in my career. I feel hopeful that I can continue to develop both personally and professionally

and Solution Psychology and build a meaningful career helping and supporting young people and families.

Our practice is unique and our approach is collaborative. You will be part of a team and the Solution Psychology family - our practice values guide everything that we do.








LIFESTYLE
